

Rule 2.6 Town Hall Meetings

- A. Town Hall meetings are not to be representative of the city council as a whole, rather, they are informal gatherings within small geographic areas, usually within a district, for the purpose of discussing a project, meeting with residents, or providing information on a specific project.
 - 1. No official action may be taken.
- B. Any member of the Council may call for a Town Hall meeting.
 - 1. The sponsoring council member;
 - a. Must inform all other council members; and
 - b. Is responsible for the distribution of flyers,
- C. Council Staff will assist in coordinating meeting logistics, including room scheduling, flyer creation, support staff needs, etc.
