Judge Ronald Kunz administered the Oath of Office to Mayor Dirk Burton. City Recorder Tangee Sloan subsequently administered the Oath of Office to Council Member Elect Chad Lamb for District 1, Bob Bedore for District 2, Zach Jacob for District 3, and Kent Shelton for District 4.

5. REMARKS - Newly Elected Officials

Mayor Dirk Burton acknowledged taking the oath of office four years prior and expressed gratitude to the staff for their assistance during his tenure. He emphasized that the residents are his priority and thanked them for their support, expressing eagerness to continue working side by side in his coming term.
