12 **2-6-1: RELATIONSHIP TO CITY:**

13 The city may provide monetary and non-monetary assistance to individuals and entities for the
14 safety, health, prosperity, moral well-being, peace, order, comfort, and convenience of city
15 residents. The city will not become employees, representatives, or agents of any city-supported
16 individual or entity solely by virtue of the city providing assistance. (Ord. 10-08, 2-24-2010;

18 **2-6-2: APPLICATIONS:**

19 Individuals and entities may request monetary and non-monetary city assistance by completing an
20 application obtained from the council office director located at the City Hall. Any questions
21 regarding the application process or requirements to receive assistance should be directed toward
22 the council office director. (Ord. 10-08, 2-24-2010; amd. Ord. 19-53, 12-11-2019, Effective at 12
23 noon on January 6, 2020; Ord. 20-38, 9-30-2020; Ord. 20-23, XX-XX-2023)

24 **2-6-3: REQUIREMENTS:**

25 All individuals and entities receiving city support shall agree to the following requirements:

26 A. The requesting individual or entity shall permit the city or an auditor hired by the city to
27 inspect the individual or entity’s system of accounts and other accounting systems and protocols to
28 ensure accuracy and proper safeguarding of public funds.

29 B. The requesting individual or entity shall provide financial reports in a form and frequency
30 acceptable by the city council.

31 C. The requesting individual or entity shall explain how the requested assistance will further
32 advance city goals or plans, and shall track the actual advancement of city goals or plans through
33 the use of the requested city assistance. Any city assistance shall be used only for the purposes
34 stated in the application and the authorizing resolution.

35 D. The requesting individual or entity shall have the training and experience needed to
36 effectively and efficiently manage the proposed activities. (Ord. 10-08, 2-24-2010; amd. Ord. 19-
